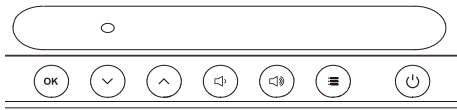

Camera status light Camera



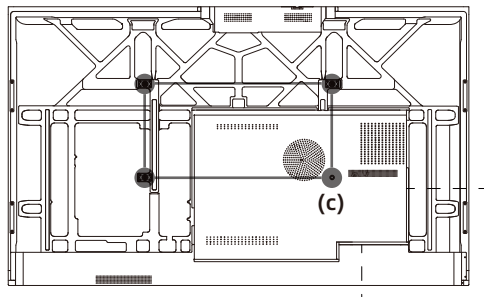

# Connect Pro Receiver



**\*Please install the Connect Pro Receiver before power on product.**

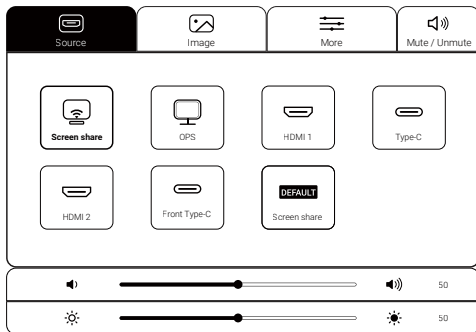
Insert the Connect Pro Receiver into the HDMI port on top of the CT display. This port is exclusively for the receiver. If needed, secure it with the included M3 screws.



Connect Pro Receiver does not support hot plugging. Therefore, you must insert or remove the receiver when the display is powered off. Otherwise, the panel display or the receiver may be damaged.

# Display menu

Press the menu button on the display or remote control to open the display menu. Navigate using the arrow keys, and press OK to select and confirm your choice.



**Source:** Select an icon to switch sources, and select the “default” icon to set a source as default.

**Image:** Select an image mode or customize your own settings by adjusting image properties.

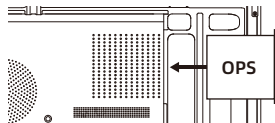
**More:** Access extra display settings like language, aspect ratio, color range, and factory reset.

# Sources and connections

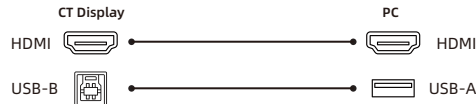
## OPS

Remove the metal cover on the OPS slot. Then, insert the OPS into the OPS slot on the back of display.



## HDMI 1 & HDMI 2

Connect your device by using a HDMI cable and USB B-A cable.



## Front & Rear Type-c

Connect your device using a USB-C to USB-C cable to a full-featured USB-C port on your laptop.



## Screen share

Switch the source to “Screen Share”, follow the instructions on the Connect Pro interface to start sharing your screen.

# Connect Pro

With Connect Pro, the CT display supports screen sharing via Airplay, Miracast, Chromecast, and Innex Connect Pro Button. Access the built-in camera wirelessly from your laptop with the Innex Connect Pro Button.

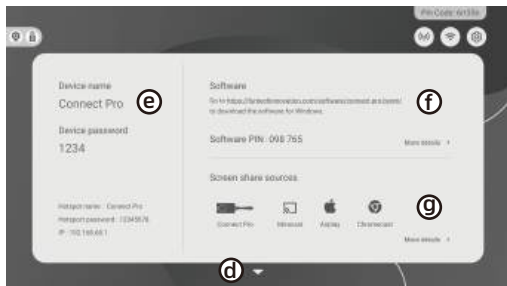
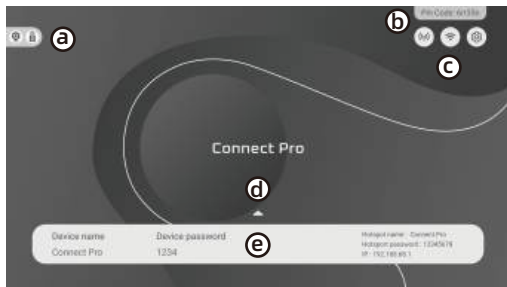

## Innex Connect Pro Button

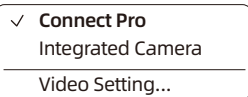
Please pair the button with display before use. Plug the Connect Pro Button into the USB port of receiver on the top of display, the pairing will start automatically. Follow on-screen instructions to complete setup.



Plug the Connect Pro Button into a full-featured USB-C laptop port. Once the status light turns slow flashing white, press the button to start or pause screen sharing.



To access display camera, microphone and speaker wirelessly, in your video conference software, select "Connect Pro" as your camera, microphone and speaker.
